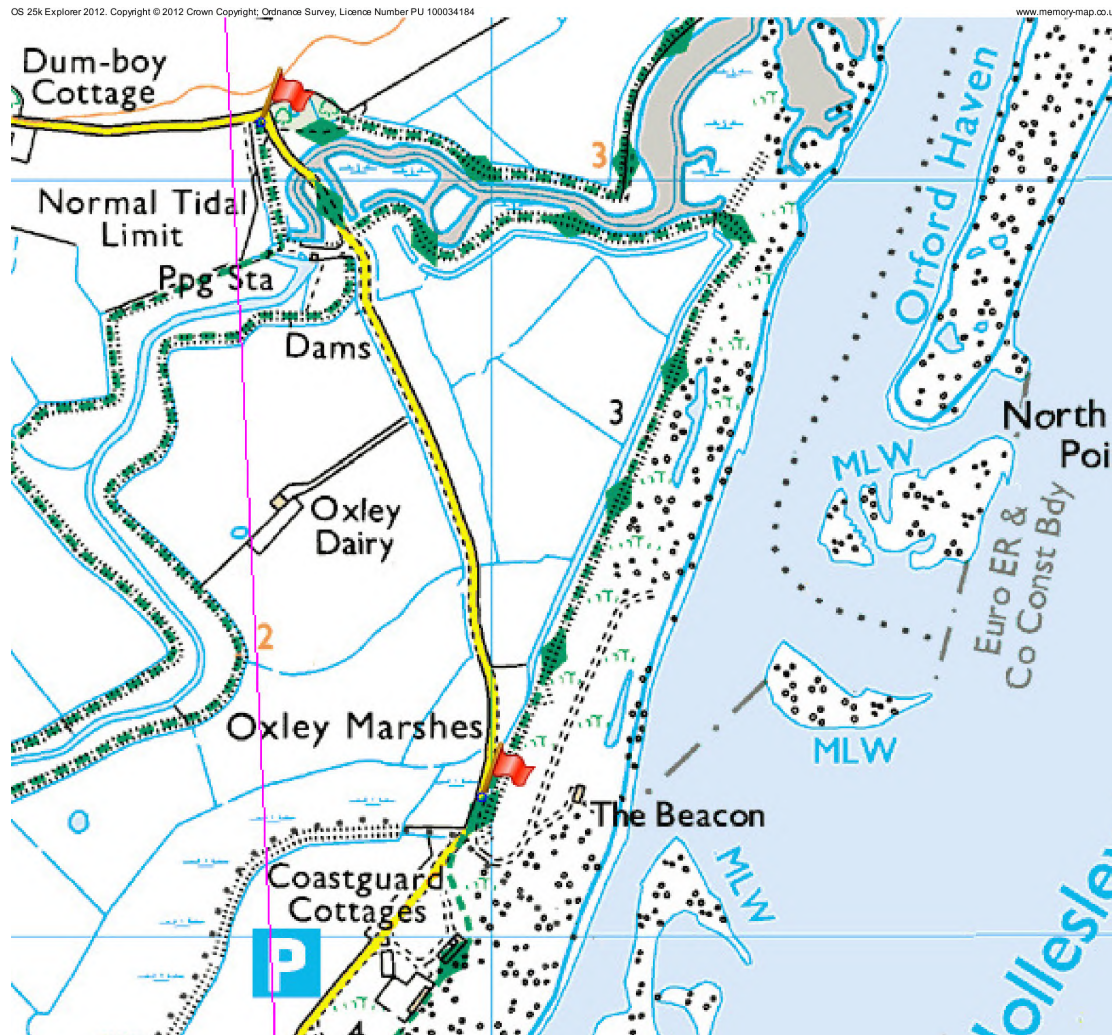

River wall inspected



Grass was cut February 2014

Levee from Coastguard Cottages to 374439 breached on 6.12.13, fully repaired within 8 days. Breach repair now covered with anchored sacking to protect grass seed. Very little grass has grown through yet.



See also photo of clay washed from breach extending into borrow dyke.

This length of levee protected by grassed foreshore and shingle beach is open to wave action in heavy weather due to movement of off-shore banks. This beach has been rolled back onto saltings since last summer. Beach level has returned to pre surge levels.

Slump forming on landward side at 371432 (opposite Beacons Cottage) Part rear slope covered with nettles and alexanders.



Length of levee around 373439 along Barthorps Creek only 2M from bank of creek

Close to road at 368439 inner slope very steep, app 60 degrees.

Levee in front of pumping station topped with concrete wall, from 376438 to 336442 trees felled and grass cut February 2014
